Anyone who believes that Australian wine has become drab/bland/mediocre/one-dimensional need look no further than the latest instalment of Mother's Milk from the First Drop team. Anything but ordinary, this is the Barossa New School at its finest, forging deliciously drinkable and affordable wines that you don't need a knife and fork for.

Cool, dark fruit coupled with a judicious use of oak (15 months in 95 per cent old French oak hogsheads with just a smidge of new American making up the numbers) make this drink-now wine well worth the hunt – although with only several thousand cases made, you'd be wise to get hunting sooner rather than later.
